

NEW SOCIAL HOUSING, Henbury, Bristol - Occupied!

This is an award-winning building project; the works were spread across three separate former garage sites in Bristol. The scheme comprised of 20 dwellings; 16 flats and 4 bungalows. The buildings were constructed of timber frame with an external brick cladding, slated pitched roofs; sarnafil dormers and timber and aluminium composite windows and doors. Works were completed in line with Passivhaus principles following specialist training undertaken by the team.

NEW WAREHOUSE

This was a Design & Build project that was taken from concept through to construction to create a new warehouse area and 2 storey office space and showroom. The building was constructed of a steel frame portal and cladding system - designed to suit the end user's requirements but also constructed to enable this to be made into a separate unit if required. The structure was designed to match the adjacent and adjoining buildings of the existing industrial estate incorporating onsite parking and a forklift and lorry turning / delivery area.



MARKSBURY ROAD SURGERY, Bristol - Open to Patients!

This new Health Centre was completed in September and was constructed of a Cross-Laminated Timber Frame System (CLT) with a brick cladding to create 14 consulting rooms, 2 minor ops and 4 treatment rooms, admin offices, waiting areas, large reception area, new pharmacy building, off-road parking facility for patients and a secure parking area for staff. The parking area was constructed of a permeable drainage system. This stunning health centre is part of Bridge View Medical, uniting 4 south Bristol GP Surgeries, aiming to provide care excellence by sharing best practice.







GYM EXTENSION-SPORTS TRAINING VILLAGE University of Bath - Nearing Completion!

External refurbishment of a whole secondary school in South Somerset which includes the replacement of all the existing windows, cladding, soffit, fascia and rainwater goods. All this is being completed whilst the school is fully functioning and continuing with its daily routine. Futures for Somerset commissioned us to do the works due to other similar projects successfully completed in live school environments.

The construction of a new 3 storey extension and refurbishment of part of the existing building. The extension creates an additional 14 new bedrooms with en-suites, communal areas and offices. Continuous liaison with the hospital has been critical and required throughout the project as the works has had to be carefully planned and scheduled around the hospital to enable phased completion of the works to be achieved prior to the commencement of the next phase. During the project further works were instructed with the refurbishment of an existing wing to create a further 4 bedrooms with en-suites, including day breakout areas and treatment rooms. Phases 1-2 were completed in October with phase 3 due for completion in December and phases 4 and 5 in Spring 2019.
