The project comprised construction of a detached single storey building, traditionally built with concrete floors, block work cavity walls, trussed roof and associated ground works, including drainage.

The new education and visitors centre, funded by South Somerset District Council (SSDC), replaces the former shipping container that the Park Rangers were based in previously and includes a coffee shop, toilet facilities and facilities for the park rangers and volunteers. The centre also houses innovative water saving technology in the toilets and volunteers' wet room which was, in part, funded by a Sustainable Watermark Award from Wessex Water.

We worked in partnership with SSDC Project Manager, Nicola Drew. The project was also nominated for the Construction News Awards 2016, Project of the Year below £10million.
