We have undertaken multiple projects for St Marys School in Calne. On this occasion we had to perform alteration works on a Grade One listed building which is used as a dormitory, this included refurbishing bathrooms, study areas, common rooms, and kitchens. The work consisted of re-flooring and re-decorating throughout, and the installation of new bathrooms and kitchens. This building had many historical features which needed to be protected and renovated, for example, fireplaces, wood panelling, decorative covings, original doors and surrounds and staircases. We also built a large extension that is now attached to the Grade One listed property. This new building was a completely new build and we created internal openings from the new building to the old. The design of the building was modern in construction using stone and brick, but there was still strict restrictions to how the finished project should look, ensuring that the stonework and pointing in was in keeping with the style of the attached Grade One listed building.
