This beautiful local historical building has undergone a full refurbishment inside, this has including a full strip out, and major structural alterations to create a large open space within the ground floor for the local library to move into. Other major structural works included the creation of a lift shaft to install a much need lift to the building. Renewal of mechanical and electrical services have been undertaken throughout the building, and state of the art data and security services have also been fitted. A new kitchen and numerus WC's have been added to the building, while plastering, new internal doors and glazing, flooring and decoration has been undertaken throughout to give the building a fresh new look.

Externally the building was wrapped in scaffolding throughout the project to enable restoration works to the original windows, downpipes, hoppers and guttering, the external stonework was also racked out and re-pointed.
